## 3:21 am

There must be a billion stars just above my head. If only everyone could see this... Another star streaks across the sky. The gentle water laps at the sand a few yards away. I'm lulled back to sleep.

## 6:32 am

"Coffee!" The exuberant cry from our guides echos across the canyon walls. I peek out from my sleeping bag. The sun casts a warm glow across the 2,000 foot walls towering around me.

## 7:06 am

3:22 pm

I sink my teeth into a warm dutch oven blueberry muffin followed by a bite of fresh grapefruit. I bury my toes into the cool sand. Watching the river drift by, I smile, anticipating what awaits downstream.

## 10:42am

I follow our guide on a narrow trail through tall vegetation. The air is suddenly filled with mist and the sound of thundering water. A spectacular stream gushes from a crack in the redrock cliffs. Breathtaking!

## 12:26 pm

Why does a sandwich taste so good out here? Perhaps it's the fresh air, warm sun, and cool water where my feet are dangling. Or maybe it's the way our guides carefully lay out all the fixings. Whatever it is, the food is fabulous. Sipping my ice-cold lemonade, I reflect on the early explorations of John Wesley Powell just recounted by our guide. "The most sublime spectacle in nature" Powell called this place. I lay back and gaze up. Sublime indeed...

## 8:10 am

I bring my gear down to the river's edge. The guides are securing the camp supplies and personal items to the rafts. I snap a photo before we load onto the boat and push away from the shore.

## 9:31 am

We drift in and out of cool shadows. The sound of a Canyon Wren is overtaken by a distant rumble... Whitewater. I slip into my raingear to stay warm in the early morning shade and take a seat up front.

## 9:33 am

My grip tightens. The bow of our boat is submerged in a mountainous wave. Cool water crashes over us, stifling screams of excitement. Then all is calm. Laughter fills the air. I have never felt so alive.

## 4:57 pm

Raindrops begin tickling the surface of the river. Downstream, I see small waterfalls beginning to pour from the canyon rim. The sandstone silt mixes in the emerald water like a magic potion.

## 6:42pm

I breathe in the delicious aroma of dinner being cooked by our guides. We toast to the perfect day with our new friends! Dazzling light dances across the river as sun drops behind the canyon walls.

## 9:02pm

We relax on our cots. Darkness starts to set in. The stars are just beginning their show overhead. Whispers about our incredible day quickly turn to sleep. **We will never be the same.**

#### Western's J-Rig

Bigger rapids demand bigger rafts such as Western's patented J-Rig. Where the Colorado River carves through Cataract Canyon earlier in the summer and on our Grand Canyon trips, J-Rigs are the vessel of choice for maximum excitement and safety. Environmentally friendly, quiet 4-stroke motors power these rugged rafts specially built for Western.



#### High-Speed Snout Rig

On our 2-Day Cataract Canyon trip, our custom snout rigs skim across the calm water sections and provide huge excitement in the whitewater.



#### Oar Boat

On all Desolation Canyon, Idaho, and Oregon trips plus Cataract Canyon and Westwater Canyon (later in the summer), guides adeptly maneuver three to sixpassenger oar boats. These specially designed 18-foot rafts are "self-bailing" which means that you'll never touch a bail bucket, except for an impromptu water fight!



#### Paddleboat

On all Idaho and Oregon trips plus Cataract Canyon and Westwater Canyon (when water levels allow), you can join the spirited crew of a paddleboat.



#### Inflatable Kayak ("Duckie")

When water levels are suitable, two-person inflatable kayaks let you challenge the rapids on your own during Utah's Desolation Canyon and Idaho and Oregon trips When you're ready to kick back and relax, simply return to your oar boat, stretch out in the sun, and let your guide do the work.

## Western's J-Rig Raft

Named after Western's founder, Jack Curry, the "J-Rig" is a patented craft offering the most flexible and comfortable ride on the river. If you're a thrill seeker, you can sit up front where the waves hit hardest, or ride aft for more protection. There are plenty of calm sections along the river where you can move freely around the boat and trade seating positions throughout the trip.

## **Campfire Dinner with Flair**






## AMAZING GUIDES & LEADERS






## Grand Canyon 3 Day Expedition

## **Trip Itinerary**

#### DAY 1

Enjoy a beautiful **flight** from Las Vegas to Bar 10 Ranch on the rim of Grand Canyon. Shortly after your arrival, a helicopter will take you deep into Grand Canyon to meet your guides. After an orientation and introductions, you'll be on your way downstream. Top off your day with a stop at Pumpkin Springs.

#### DAY 2

Our J-Rig rafts enter awesome Lower Granite Gorge with a series of moderate rapids. Take some time to hike and play at Travertine Grotto, a series of hidden waterfalls and pools. Then run the biggest rapids of the trip, the "230's."

### DAY 3

The river calms and the canyon widens. Savor a final morning in Grand Canyon. Then head downriver and ride a jet boat into Lake Mead where a deluxe motor coach will be waiting to return you to Las Vegas.

On our 4-Day Grand Canyon Expedition, you can start your 3-day trip with an overnight at the Bar 10 Ranch where you'll experience a horseback trail ride, skeet shooting, cowboy entertainment and more.



## **Trip Itinerary**

#### DAYS 1 & 2

Take a charter flight from Las Vegas or meet in Marble Canyon, Arizona. Drift lazily while taking in the magnificent views of the canyon. Experience mighty **House Rock Rapid** and the Roaring 20's. Visit **Vasey's Paradise**, a spectacular cascade of water supporting a hanging garden and **Redwall Cavern**, a vast chamber carved by the river.

#### DAYS 3 & 4

The canyon gets wider, giving views of both North and South rims, before narrowing into Granite Gorge where you'll experience Hance, Horn Creek, Granite, Hermit and Crystal... all rapids respected for their huge waves. Western's knowledgeable guides lead short hikes to hidden Elves Chasm and pounding Deer Creek Falls.

#### DAY 5

Hike up renowned **Havasu Canyon** where countless tranquil pools and waterfalls invite swimming and relaxing. Continue downriver through jaw-dropping scenery.

### DAY 6 OR 7

Raft **Lava Falls**. Exit the canyon by **helicopter** to Bar 10 Ranch for a shower and lunch before your return flight to Marble Canyon or Las Vegas. 

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


## **Cataract Canyon** 2 or 4 Day Expedition


**Desolation Canyon** 5 Day Expedition

**CHOOSING YOUR ADVENTURE »** We want to make sure that the vacation package you select is an adventure of a lifetime. Rest assured, we will make every possible effort to ensure your comfort and safety while traveling with us. We have a five decade history of satisfied guests, and we are excited to have you join their ranks.

During the pre-trip planning process, we often receive a number of questions related to choosing which trip is best for you, the nature of a river trip, what to expect during the trip, and what degree of physical conditioning is required. While we have found that we can accommodate a wide range of abilities on all of our rafting trips, the better prepared you are, the more you will enjoy yourself.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR GUESTS » Our primary concern is participant safety. The nature of an outdoor adventure involves some physical exertion and also possible exposure to weather conditions that can fluctuate greatly due to heat, sun, wind, or rain. Although we do have experience accommodating persons with a wide range of physical challenges, disabilities, or medical and health conditions, we have found that for some people the fact of age, weight, lack of conditioning, heart or other disease, can create additional hardship that diminishes the suitability or enjoyment of this type of vacation. Please consider these conditions in making your choice of river adventures. Please check with your physician prior to your trip if you have any medical or health condition or if you are taking any medications, and then notify us of how we can better help you with these conditions. In general, participants will need to meet the following physical requirements:

- Fit into a Type 5 Life Jacket (maximum chest size 52") required by the National Park Service.
- Securely grip ropes provided for handholds while running the rapids.
- Climb on and off the rafts. Depending on type of raft this could be as much as a 2-3-foot reach and often on wet and slippery surfaces.
- Navigate uneven terrain on hikes and in camp.
- Carry your own dry bag which will include your 20-pound duffle bag along with the sleeping bag and ground cover we provide.

Our principle objective is for you and your fellow guests to have a safe, enjoyable and fulfilling experience. If you are concerned about any of these requirements, please call our friendly staff to further discuss which trip is right for you. Our Acknowledgement of Risk Form will more fully describe some of the inherent risks involved in these activities. We look forward to having you join us on the adventure of a lifetime.

A TYPICAL DAY ON THE RIVER » After meeting your guides you will be given a trip orientation that will include how and where you can sit on the rafts, how to hold on, and safety precautions while on the river.

A typical day will include rafting for a few hours at a time, stopping for scenic side-canyon hikes, bathroom breaks, lunch and possible swimming opportunities. Visiting with new-found friends and learning river lore and geology from our well-trained guides adds to the enjoyment of each day.

After a full day of learning and fun we arrive in camp. Guests will find their personal campsite and then return to the rafts for the famous "fireline"-the way we load and unload rafts. Your help in passing the gear off the boat is greatly appreciated; however, if you have physical restrictions or limitations that would prohibit you from participating, you are not required to help.

The first evening in camp, the guides will give a demonstration on how to easily assemble the cots and tents and will be available to help you if you need additional assistance. Western River provides cots, tents, sleeping bags, sheets, camp chair and water-proof gear bags for all guests. You'll have no need to worry about bringing any of your own camping equipment.

While you relax at the river's edge, your guides will prepare dinner. Every night is different, but the menu may include items such as grilled chicken breast, steak with sautéed onions, pasta or fresh fish.

At night, whether you choose to sleep in your tent or under the vast canopy of stars, the fresh night air and the rhythm of the river will lull you to sleep.

Each morning, your guides will prepare a delicious breakfast. You'll have a chance to enjoy eating before returning to your campsite to take down your tent and cot and pack up your belongings in your dry bag. After bringing your bag down to the boats, guests participate in the fireline once again and you are off on another fun-filled day of adventure.
